

INTO THE GREENBELT : FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

We're excited you're group is interested in exploring Ontario's Greenbelt! To further assist you through the planning process, we've compiled a few Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs).

Can I use the bursary to explore a destination not on the travel itinerary?

We are always looking for new Greenbelt locations to add to the program and we will continue to update the site as new and exciting destinations are secured. At this time however, we request that you select from the list of existing partnered destinations.

What level of detail should be captured in the budget?

The bursary is intended to offset associated travel expenses for your trip (i.e. bus rental, transit passes or personal taxis). If you'd prefer to allocate the bursary to additional items please specify in the budget.

Do I need to fill the bus I rented?

Filling a chartered bus with a group of 25-40 people will maximize the value of your bursary.

Can I apply for more than one group?

We are not limiting you to one submission; however - consider combining groups to maximize both travel and programming costs.

Are there items for purchase at all of the destinations?

You don't need to spend money to have a good time. There are a number of free activities to enjoy at the sites! However, if you desire, many destinations have items for purchase or rental. We encourage participants to have some additional money with them on the day to cover any optional expenses.

Do I need to advise Park People of my travel plans?

All groups are advised to contact the destination of their choice to coordinate specific activities and to confirm your trip. Park People requires you to confirm your date of travel and the number of participants who attended when completing our online program evaluation. There is also an opportunity to share any photo highlights of your trip at that time!
