A \$400 bursary is available for 25 Clubs to be put towards the cost of a trip. The bursary is estimated to cover half or more of the travel expenses for a group of 40 children and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

There are many destinations to choose from including fun farm tours, conservation areas with scenic hiking trails; as well as beautiful beaches great for swimming or paddling.
